The materialistic approach to Christmas is illustrated by an incident that took place in front of a department store window. Two ladies were Christmas window shopping. The window had a display of various gifts and as a background John 3:16 was written out in letters of gold on black velvet: "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." Said one lady to the other, "What will these Christians think of next? They are even trying to put Christianity into Christmas!"
